CHURCH AT HOME

Hi Daily Church Family, I'm Pastor Jordan

Our vision at Daily Church is to **Develop and Deploy you to start a Church at Home**. Today you have applied to start a church at home and we are excited for you the ministry that God has planned for your life.

Are you ready? Let's learn the 4 simple steps to starting your Church at Home. There are 4 words for starting a Daily church, it is:

**INVITE,
WATCH,
TALK,
PRAY**

That's it!

Each DAILY Church is home for just **1 HOUR** and that is broken down into the 4 steps.

**INVITE, 10 mins
WATCH, 20 mins
TALK, 20 mins
PRAY 10 mins**

Let's dive into these 4 steps as you lead your Church at Home with us weekly on the weekends.

1. INVITE - 10 Mins

We have to be INTENTIONAL about our FAITH. WHY? Because our faith matters! Our faith is so important. Our faith:

- Saves us
- Gives us hope for daily living
- Leads others to believe in Jesus

STORY: The Woman at the Well.

Jesus could have proposed 1,000 different paths in life, but he chose to seek out lost people. Why? Because he believed Lost People were worth giving his life to save.

In the same way you and I are SAVE, but how do we see the lost?

Are we passionate about them coming to Jesus?

If you didn't care about Lost people, you wouldn't be

starting a CHURCH at Home!

What did Jesus have? He had Intentionality. Jesus was intentional! Jesus stayed all day at a Well, just to talk to one person.

LETS READ

John 4:27-42: Woman at the Well

27 Just then his disciples returned and were surprised to find him talking with a woman. But no one asked, “What do you want?” or “Why are you talking with her?” 28 Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, 29 “Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?” 30 They came out of the town and made their way toward him. 31 Meanwhile his disciples urged him, “Rabbi, eat something.”

32 But he said to them, “I have food to eat that you know nothing about.” 33 Then his disciples said to each other, “Could someone have brought him food?” 34 “My food,” said Jesus, “is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. 35 Don’t you have a saying, ‘It’s still four months until harvest’? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. 36 Even now the one who reaps draws a wage and harvests a crop for

eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together.

Many Samaritans Believe

39 Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did." 40 So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days. 41 And because of his words many more became believers. 42 They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."

What do we learn from this Story?

1. People are waiting to be invited!!

They want to be invited into God's plan and into God's story of redemption. If you invite people, they will invite their friends and the movement of Jesus will Grow to reach your city!

2. Jesus STARTED Somewhere: Jesus started at a Well to reach a City.

- Start a weekly meet up at your home. Invite people to have coffee with you or a Meal. Have fellowship at your home

3. Jesus was INTENTIONAL: Jesus waited with a Purpose.

- You have a purpose, it's to bring others closer to Jesus. You have to be Intentional to reach people!

4. Jesus WAITED for the Harvest: Jesus disciples left him

- You may feel you are the only one left doing the ministry. Keep going, don't give up because a harvest is coming! A city will come to Christ because you are believing! It may not look like it, it may look like 1 person praying, but with God on your side, you will see a Harvest. A City Saved.

5. Jesus reached a City through ONE PERSON: Jesus reached 1 person who brought an entire City to God.

- In the bible we call the woman at the well a person of peace. God can use one person to bring an entire village or city to Christ. This one person can reach people you cannot reach. Jesus had a vision of reaching a city who needed God but he waited to find that one person. You have to wait for God to bring that person of peace.

2. WATCH - 20 Mins

Next, watch a Talk from DAILY Church. As you invite people and meet up weekly at your home, take time to watch a DAILY Talk, a message from the Bible

DAILY Talks and messages are Chapter by Chapter through the Bible. So open your bibles and watch a Message and as you watch have people listen to God's voice.

Every person is waiting to hear God speak to them and in this moment of 20 mins we want everyone to hear the VOICE of God speaking through The Bible.

STORY: Philip and the Eunuch

People are waiting to hear God speak to them! When God speaks to a person, everything Changes! People want to hear the VOICE OF GOD.

LETS READ

Acts 8:26-38 Philip and the Eunuch

26 Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Go south to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." 27 So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian[a] eunuch, an important official in charge of all the treasury of the Kandake (which means

“queen of the Ethiopians”). This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship, 28 and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the Book of Isaiah the prophet. 29 The Spirit told Philip, “Go to that chariot and stay near it.” 30 Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. “Do you understand what you are reading?” Philip asked. 31 “How can I,” he said, “unless someone explains it to me?” So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

32 This is the passage of Scripture the eunuch was reading: “He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth. 33 In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth.” 34 The eunuch asked Philip, “Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?” 35 Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus.

36 As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, “Look, here is water. What can stand in the way of my being baptized?” [37] 38 And he gave orders to stop the chariot. Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.

What do we learn from this Story?

1. The Eunuch was **HUNGRY** to hear the Voice God:

People are hungry to hear the Bible. The Eunuch was searching and hungry to hear from God.

2. The Eunuch listened to Philips **MESSAGE**:

Philip read the Scriptures.

3. The Eunuch got **SAVED**:

Through the reading of the Bible, people will come to Jesus.

3. TALK - 20 Mins

Next TALK about what you have just heard, After you watch a Talk from DAILY Church talk about what you heard God speaking to you!

As you talk together this should be a **Group Discussion**, every one should have something today. The Leader of Host of your Group just facilitates the discussion and as people talk you will find God speaking through what

people have learned.

You can Ask questions like this:

- What did God speak to you as we read the Bible?
- Share What you observed?
- What does this Scripture teach us about God?
- What does this Scripture teach us about People?
- How do we Obey this Scripture?
- Who is a Person we can tell?

STORY: On the Road to Emmaus

Jesus had just risen from the Dead! Now the Word of God was spreading all over town. People were TALKING! They were discussing the Message of Jesus. While a few believers were walking and talking, Jesus showed up in their midst.

LETS READ

Luke 24:13–32 - On the Road to Emmaus

13 Now that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles[a] from Jerusalem. 14 They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. 15 As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; 16 but they were kept from recognizing

him. 17 He asked them, "What are you discussing together as you walk along?" They stood still, their faces downcast. 18 One of them, named Cleopas, asked him, "Are you the only one visiting Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"

19 "What things?" he asked. "About Jesus of Nazareth," they replied. "He was a prophet, powerful in word and deed before God and all the people. 20 The chief priests and our rulers handed him over to be sentenced to death, and they crucified him; 21 but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel. And what is more, it is the third day since all this took place. 22 In addition, some of our women amazed us. They went to the tomb early this morning 23 but didn't find his body. They came and told us that they had seen a vision of angels, who said he was alive.

24 Then some of our companions went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said, but they did not see Jesus." 25 He said to them, "How foolish you are, and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" 27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

28 As they approached the village to which they were going, Jesus continued on as if he were going farther. 29 But they urged him strongly, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening; the day is almost over." So he went in to stay with them. 30 When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them.

31 Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. 32 They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

What do we learn from this Story?

1. Jesus was PRESENT as they TALKED:

I find it fascinating the when two or more gather in Jesus name, Jesus promises to be in our Midst too. This is the power of the Church and talking about the Bible.

Matthew 18:20

20 For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."

2. Jesus was part of a DISCUSSION GROUP:

17 He asked them, "What are you discussing together as you walk along?" - You could say they had a Church that

day, with Jesus as a small group discussing the Bible together.

3. Jesus OPENED the Scriptures to them:

The early disciples were amazed at how Jesus had opened the Scriptures to them. When we invite Jesus to our Gathering and as we talk, let's expect Jesus to reveal his words to us.

4. PRAY - 10 Mins

Lastly, Pray for each other's needs. We all need prayer!

Lets read some Verses about Prayer:

Mark 11:24: “Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”

Matthew 21:22: “If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.”

John 14:13: “And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.”

John 15:7: “If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”

John 16:23: “Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.”

What do we learn from this Story?

1. God wants to ANSWER your prayers

So pray for each other!!

Close your Daily Church meeting with Prayer!

Let's pray now for you!

God I thank you that you have given us a great plan for reaching our City for Christ. I pray that you would help my friend to invite others to join them. I pray that you could put on their heart people you are calling them to reach for Christ and I pray that they would be encouraged today! In Jesus name, Amen!

HOST YOUR CHURCH

As a Leader of your Group, you are the Host of your Church at Home. Here are a few things I want to encourage with:

1. Everything starts SMALL.

Jesus had 12 disciples. You would think Jesus needed a MegaChurch of 1,000's to change the world with the Gospel, but instead he chose only 12 people!

2. What will you do with a FEW People.

With these 12 he poured his life into and then began to become the leaders of Churches all over Israel and beyond.

3. MUSTARD SEED Faith.

In the same way Jesus will give you a few people, but have faith. Jesus says this about how the Kingdom of God works:

Matthew 17:20

He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

NOTHING is IMPOSSIBLE for you!

This is the promise Jesus is giving your Church Group right now. Start with the small and let God make it grow.

Making Disciples

Matthew 28:19

19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

As you go I want you to think of 4 Groups of People God will call you to Invest in.

The 4 C's of Leadership:

1. CROWD
2. COMMUNITY
3. CORE
4. COMMISSION

1. CROWD - Where is Your Crowd?

ANSWER: Your City is your Crowd.

Jesus ministered to a crowd:

John 6:2

and a great crowd of people followed him because they saw the signs he had performed by healing the sick.

Luke 14:23-24 - Invite everyone

23 “Then the master told his servant, ‘Go out to the roads and country lanes and compel them to come in, so that my house will be full. 24 I tell you, not one of those who were invited will get a taste of my banquet.’”

2. COMMUNITY - Who is Your Community?

Jesus ministered to a Community that followed him, Who came to listen to his messages.

ANSWER: Your Church is your Community.

3. CORE - Who is Your CORE?

Jesus had a close Core, the 12.

ANSWER: Your Leadership Team is your Core.

4. COMMISSION - Who ARE YOU COMMISSIONING?

Jesus CALLS us to make disciples, who make disciples.

2 Timothy 2:2

1You therefore, my child, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. 2And the things that you have heard me say among many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be qualified to teach others as well.

Lets Pray!
